VICAR'S MESSAGE 8 JAN 2023

Dear COA family,

Last Sunday I preached from the text from Hebrews 6:1-12 encouraging us to embark on the journey of growth in our spiritual lives and to take active steps in that direction. This is because our faith is ultimately a journey with a starting point to maturity in Christ (Colossians 1:28). Our God desires us to become spiritually mature and not simply stay as stunted Christians.

Yet Hebrews 6 is also one of the most frightening passages in the New Testament. There we read about the severe consequences of turning away deliberately from God and persisting in sinful behaviour. The final result would be to forfeit one's salvation, which is the greatest loss anyone could ever experience!

Here are the words of the passage:

*"For it is impossible to bring back to repentance those who were once enlightened—those who have experienced the good things of heaven and shared in the Holy Spirit, who have tasted the goodness of the word of God and the power of the age to come— and who then turn away from God. **It is impossible to bring such people back to repentance; by rejecting the Son of God, they themselves are nailing him to the cross once again and holding him up to public shame.**" Hebrews 6:4-6*

There are teachers in Christian circles who would try to explain the consequences away by claiming that these are not true Christians to begin with. They claim that these people merely tasted the goodness of God without receiving it. This is because these teachers hold on to the view that salvation, once obtained, can never be lost.

Yet this way of reading is to use a pre-determined mindset to understand a verse. And invariably, it will lead to a wrong view. The plain text of this passage clearly indicates that loss of salvation is possible – and will take place if one wilfully turns his back on God (see also Hebrews 10:26-31). This terrifying consequence can really happen to people!

I am not saying that we should therefore be paranoid about our salvation status or judge *those who have "lost" their salvation. Ultimately, it is the Lord who truly judges each one.*

Yet I am saying that there is a direction that one can take that leads to eternal ruin and go past the point of no return. The heart can become so hardened and the conscience become so seared that turning back to God in trust and tenderness of spirit becomes problematic. At this point, the author of Hebrews calls it "impossible".

Let us then be wary of turning away from God deliberately nor even tolerate sin or compromise in our lives. After all, in this journey of faith, if we are not moving forward, we are moving backwards. Let us determine to grow intentionally in our lives through godly thoughts, actions and responses.

We are looking for volunteers to partner us in our chaplaincy outreach to SAJS boys. We invite you prayerfully consider volunteering for one or more of the following ministries.

Saints' Haven

Saints' Haven is a recess ministry that runs across the 3 recesses in SAJS. The boys come into our drop-in room to chill out. Board and card games are available for them to unwind and socialise.

Using game-playing as a platform to build friendships, we minister to the boys by patiently hearing what they have to say and speaking into their lives. Opportunities for prayer may arise as well.

Commitment:

1-2 volunteers on any one or more days from Mon to Thu, 9.25 – 10.55 AM, in SAJS, during school term.
Please come in earlier (9.15 AM) to help set up the place with games and prayers.

SAJS Praying Parents

The SAJS Praying Parents is part of the nationwide Praying Parents Unite! group that galvanises parents to pray and intercede for their schools.

We meet onsite weekly to cover the students, staff and parents of SAJS in prayer. Additional prayer meetings are also organised during important examination periods (eg. PSLE).

If you have a heart and/or burden to pray, we encourage you to join us. You do not need to be a SAJS parent to join the group.

CHAPLAINCY VOLUNTEERING OPPORTUNITIES

7J Boys' Brigade Singapore Company

The Object of the Boys' Brigade (BB) is "the advancement of Christ's Kingdom amongst Boys and the promotion of habits of Obedience, Reverence, Discipline, Self-Respect and all that tends towards a true Christian Manliness".

Utilising the method of Company, uniform, awards, promotion and wholesome activities, BB volunteers play an important role as mentors, helping nurture BB Boys to be men of godly character.

A typical weekday parade starts with a time of Singspiration, where praise songs are sung. Then a devotion is shared, before the boys break into their different levels to do activities like badgework, drills, soft archery or team-building games.

Other than the weekly Friday parades, volunteers are also involved in inter-school events such as the Adventure and Character Quest competitions, and community outreach events such as BB CARES and BB Share-a-Gift. Camps and outings are also organised occasionally.

Commitment:

1-4 volunteers for weekly Friday parades from 8 – 10 AM in COA, during school term. Adhoc volunteers for annual Saturday competitions and other activities (eg. camp, community outreach) are welcome too!

SAV HOPE Boyz Club/ Up & On Programme

SAV Helping Our Pupils Excel (HOPE) Boyz Club and Up & On Programme are after-school programmes that reach out to children-at-risk (Financial Assistance Scheme, latchkey, etc) identified by the school.

The boys gather for lunch after school on Wednesdays. Then a short message for the day is shared before they go into their different levels to do homework and revision (with a short break in between). Games and sports might also be played in the last period.

Sometimes outings (local and overseas) are organised to allow them to have the experience of travelling or going overseas. Past trips include an outing to Hay Dairies in 2018 and a cultural immersion trip to Chiang Mai in 2017.

P6 boys in the Up & On Programme also meet more regularly, from once a week to daily, as the PSLE draws closer.

Volunteers need not be good in any academic subjects (advantageous as that may be) – you just need a heart to journey alongside these boys and be a significant adult mentor in their lives.

Commitment:

1-2 volunteers on Wednesdays, 2-4 PM, in SAJS, during school term, from February onwards (start date TBC)

For P6s, same timing as Hope Boyz, but volunteers can commit to one or more of the 1.5-hour days from May onwards (May, Jul – Fri; end Jul-Aug: Tue, Thu, Fri; after Sep school hols-PSLE: Mon-Fri).

CHAPLAINCY VOLUNTEERING OPPORTUNITIES

Extend-A-Care Programme

Mentors with time and patience to model Christ's love are needed to encourage and listen to students who require additional emotional and academic support.

Volunteers work with the school counsellors and teachers to care for students through regular meetings to look out for these needy students and celebrate their joys and successes.

Commitment:

1-2 volunteers who can commit to meeting matched students at least once a week, before school assembly starts.

Counselling skills (active listening, naming emotions, reframing) and problem-solving skills advantageous but not necessary.
