It was at this time that the Lord graciously provided his word in Psalm 94 which is so apt and provides us, I believe, with the words to pray and hope in:

O LORD, God of vengeance, O God of vengeance, shine forth!

Rise up, O judge of the earth; repay to the proud what they deserve!

O LORD, how long shall the wicked, how long shall the wicked exult?

They pour out their arrogant words; all the evildoers boast.





#### CALL TO PRAYER

The recent developments in Gaza and Israel have profoundly shocked the international community in many different ways. We observe that the ongoing conflicts in the region have inflicted deep suffering and devastating consequences upon the people, amidst complex territorial disputes and longstanding hostility. In the process, many lives have been affected and tragically lost. We are calling the Church to intercede fervently and pray for healing over the afflicted, restoration and for a peaceful solution to the deteriorating crisis.

Dear Lord, Creator of all human beings. We are all fearfully and wonderfully created in Your own image and likeness. We agree with Your words that human lives are precious in Your sight. We are deeply saddened by the effects of wars and conflict in Gaza and Israel, killing many lives, displacing many families, destroying many homes. We pray for those who have lost their loved ones in this current conflict. Lord, in their grief, comfort them with Your peace which surpasses all understanding. Heal their souls from bitterness and envelop them with Your love. Insulate their hearts from hatred, and grant them the grace so needful to move on in their lives. Defend them, O Lord, those who are defenseless. Protect the people living in the region from the harm of war.

We pray for the supply of all that are needed: food, medical aids, financial assistance, acts of kindness and mercy, shelters for those who have lost their homes, and the peaceful passage of humanitarian personnel into the region. O Lord, we pray that the international community will contribute to the de-escalating of tension among parties in conflict. Lord, would you intervene in situations where they are beyond the reach of human efforts, that a long term peaceful solution can be achieved. Make us, Your Church, O Lord an instrument of Your peace, where there is hatred, let us sow love; where there is offence, pardon; where there is despair, hope; where there is darkness, light; where there is sadness, joy, where there is pain, consolation.

Lord, look upon all those who are suffering with Your compassion. Save us Lord, and help them those who are helpless. In the precious Name of our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ. Amen.

May the Lord guide you by His Holy Spirit as you remember Gaza and Israel in your prayers.

### 1) Community outreach at Tampines Mart

As part of the church's Community Outreach, SACC rented a place at Tampines Mart, "The Friend Space", to reach out to the residents in the vicinity. Pray for the church as they reach out to the community in Tampines.

2) Church plant at Battambang, Cambodia

SACC has been partnering with a church in Pursat, Cambodia to establish a new church plant in Battambang. Pray that the Lord will provide the resources that SACC needs.

#### 3) Manpower recruitment and renewal

Pray for successful recruitment of manpower to support SACC's Administration, Pastoral and Chaplaincy work, and Befrienders ministry in SACH.

### 2) SINGAPORE AND THE WORLD:

Israel: Pray for de-escalation of hostilities on both sides and God's protection of the lives of all civilians caught up in the conflict. Pray too for God's deliverance of all the hostages and comfort for the families who have lost loved ones.

- Pray that God will continue to lead us in our outreach to the open doors of schools, nursing homes and overseas missions so that we can be most effective and fruitful in our efforts.
- Pray for our students who are taking their year-end examinations in Oct. Pray for God's strength and wisdom to be with them and for peace on the families.
