
VICAR'S MESSAGE

Dear COA Family,

Happy New Year!

As we enter into the New Year, a question that I would like to ask is this: *Where do you seek to get your affirmation, validation and praise from*?

Naturally, many would seek to get it from others. After all, we are social creatures and live in a society.



While all of these might be valid, the bible tells us that approval and pleasure of God for our lives is the most important thing.

Jesus tells those who were disputing with him: *"How can you believe since you accept glory from one another but do not seek the glory that comes from the only God?" (John 5:44)*

In other words, as these Pharisees seek for affirmation from their peers and others, they forfeit the knowledge of God in their lives. The glory and praise of others becomes the main stumbling block to them coming to the faith of God!

The Apostle Paul also emphasizes the importance of seeking God's praise in our lives. He writes,

"A person is a Jew who is one inwardly; and circumcision is circumcision of the heart, by the Spirit, not by the written code. **Such a person's praise is not from other people, but from God**." (Romans 2:29)

Today and in this coming year, where is your validation and praise coming from? Is it from human beings alone? Or is God's favour the one that you are seeking for?

I pray that we would all seek for the approval and praise that comes from God alone – and his grace and favour would sustain us through the most difficult of tasks and situations we find ourselves in.

We warmly welcome Angelina Lim, who joined us as the New Finance Officer on 1 January 2025. She will be responsible for the financial operations of the church.






